

Last month, Lower Umpqua Library District (LULD) began a borrowing competition for all ages



and it is off to a great start! Participants earn raffle tickets by borrowing items from the library such as books, magazines, outdoor equipment, electronics, and movies, in order to complete bingo sheets of 25 items per specialty. Prize drawings will be held quarterly and annually, and the prizes will include gift certificates from local businesses.

LULD's bingo program is meant to appeal to a wide variety of interests, so there are 27 different categories to choose from. These include: Adventure/Travel, Classics, Closed Stacks, DVD, Electronic, General Interest, Graphic Novels, Historical Fiction, History, Honor System, Juvenile, Juvenile Easy, Large Print/Audiobooks, Library-use only, Music, Mysteries/Thrillers, New/Recently Added, Non-English Language, Nonfiction, Pacific Northwest, Periodicals, Recreational, Romance, Speculative Fiction, True Crime, Western, and Young Adult.

In addition to the quarterly and annual prize drawings, children who participate in the reading program can earn free books along the way, each time they complete a bingo (by reading books from five different categories in a row).
